Adult Leader Recommended Qualifications for the 2017 National Scout Jamboree

There are several key requirements for each of the 2 Boy Scout Troop contingent leader positions (8) and the 1 Venturing Crew contingent leader positions (1) which are detailed below.

A fundamental requirement is the willingness and ability to dedicate significant time and effort to recruit youth participants and prepare the contingent for the jamboree.

Monthly meetings and several weekend orientation, participant training and youth leader training sessions will be conducted in order to insure that the contingent is prepared for an experience of a lifetime. Additionally, communications, logistics, equipment planning and project management are important factors.

In addition to the position specific requirements the general requirements are:

All Adult Leaders

- Completed and have current credentials in all of the following as of 7/1/17. Youth Protection (Y01 & Y02), Weather Hazards (WS81), Safety Afloat (SA), Safe Swim Defense (SSD), and Red Cross CPR/First Aid (or *nationally recognized certification program per the American Camping Association*). For SM/ ASM1/ ASM2 positions Scoutmaster Specific (S24), Outdoor Leader Skills (S11) and Wood Badge training (A90) are required. (Older training courses prior to 1/1/2000 are not acceptable). For Venturing Advisor positions the new Venturing Advisor Specific (P21 After 1/1/2015) and Outdoor Leader Skills (S11) and are required. Wood Badge (A90) is preferred.
- For SM, 1st ASM, and Crew Advisor be at least 21 years of age by 7/19/17.
- Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- Have completed Youth Protection Training (both Y01 & Y02) within one year of the first day of the jamboree.
- Have filed with and been accepted by both Council and National the Jamboree Personal Health and Medical Record before the pre-jamboree training events
- Be approved by the Council Jamboree Committee.

Scoutmaster (2 positions)

- Be registered & serve as a Unit Leader (Scoutmaster/Coach/ Advisor/ Skipper) for at least one year & an active Unit Leader or Ass't. Unit Leader for the remaining time during the three-year period prior to 7/19/17.
- Have served as an Assistant Scoutmaster for a prior Jamboree contingent (*preferred*).

First Assistant Scoutmaster (Troop Activities) (2 positions)

- Be registered and serve as an active adult leader for a troop for at least the 3 year period prior to 7/19/17.

Second Assistant Scoutmaster (Physical Arrangements) (2 positions)

- Be registered and serve as an active adult leader.
- Be at least 18 years of age by 7/19/17. (*at least 21 years of age preferred*).

Third Assistant Scoutmaster (Scheduling and Records) (2 positions) Discounts are available to those registered by December 2016

- Be at least 18 years of age by 7/19/17 but not yet age 21 by 7/28/17. ■ Be an Eagle Scout.
- Have served actively in several troop leadership positions.
- Complete the appropriate adult leader specific training; ■ Completion of NYLT training (*preferred*).
- Completion of NAYLE training (*preferred*). ■ Prior attendance at a Jamboree as a youth (*greatly preferred*).

Venturing Crew Advisor (1 position)

- Be registered and serve as a Crew Advisor, Skipper, Associate Advisor or Mate for the 3 year period prior to 7/19/17. ■ Have completed New Venturing Leader Specific training (P21 After 1/1/2015) and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (S11).
