

Hello everyone,

I'm very excited for this year's Family Adventure Camp!

Registration will be Saturday Oct. 12th 8:30am-9:30am, activities will begin at 10am.

Unfortunately there is no water source near us so make sure you bring plenty to drink.

- There is a creek that runs behind where we are camping so if anyone would like to bring a fishing pole for after our day is over they are more than welcome to.
- Scouts are welcome to wear their Field Uniform (blue shirt) but it is recommended that they wear an Activity Uniform (scouting or plain shirt and jeans/shorts).
- Closed-toes shoes with backs are required for all. No flip-flops or sandals.
- Please come in main entrance of the park and head toward football field, we will be all the way in the back of the park close to water treatment plant.
- Check in at the table in front of the white equipment building.
- Packs/Dens are encouraged to come prepared with a song or skit to perform at the campfire.
- You will have plenty of time after our day is over to set up tents or you could come early and set it up that morning.
- Your family or your pack is responsible for any meals or snacks Saturday evening and Sunday morning.
- Departure must be complete by 10:00am Sunday. Please remember to "Leave No Trace" when you depart your camping area.
- Available facilities will be porta-pots.
- *****NOTE*** ALL FIRES MUST BE IN A RAISED FIRE PIT. NO GROUND FIRES.**

Additional supplies to bring if camping-

- Tent
- Sleeping bag and ground mat
- Clothes
- Toiletries
- Check with your Pack/Den about what food and supplies are needed for your group. All campers are in charge of their own meals, with the exception of Saturday lunch.
