

Wood Badge Scholarship Application Guidelines

Congratulations on your decision to improve your leadership skills. We understand the cost of this course is significant but we know the benefits of this training are worth far more than the dollars spent on improving our leaders.

The Wood Badge Scholarship fund exists by the generosity of those who have taken the course in the past. They are willing to assist others to share in this wonderful training experience. The Scholarship Committee's goal is to assist everyone who desires to attend Wood Badge so we have better leaders for our youth, home, church, community and nation. To accomplish that goal, the first 30 people paid in full receive a \$50 scholarship. The next 20 people paid in full receive a \$25 scholarship.

The committee does not have unlimited funds and we need your cooperation to help us fund as many folks as possible. The following guidelines are provided to assist you:

- Please provide as much detail as possible in the "Candidate Information" section.
- Please provide as much detail as possible in the "Financial Information" section.
- The Adjusted Course Fee will be contingent upon timely processing of paperwork and payments. The "Early Bird" discount is date driven. The First 30 and Next 20 Scholarships are based on the number of participants who are Paid in Full.
- Be sure to talk with your employer to see if financial assistance may be available. Contact the Course Director for a letter to the employer that explains the course and its potential impact.
- Be sure to talk with your Chartering Organization to see if financial assistance may be available.
- Many units pay a portion of training expenses. Talk with your unit committee.
- Other organization (Unions, VFW, local businesses, etc.) may have funds available. Discuss this with them.
